Exercise Overview

Join us for a facilitated Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) tabletop exercise focused on the emergent phase of a Hazmat incident. The exercise will explore various agency roles, responsibilities, capabilities, jurisdictional authorities, and resources. Participants will contemplate initial standup, incident management organization, and resources needed for an Incident Command Post and an Emergency Operations Center. Consistent with the HSEEP, the exercise will include a hot wash, evaluation of objectives, and preparation of an After Action Report.

This will be a multi-jurisdictional exercise intended for Hazmat Practitioners, Emergency Managers, Fire, Law Enforcement, Tribal, Governmental Agencies, Non-Governmental Organizations, and Technical Specialists.
